

## RESIDENTIAL CLEAN UP GUIDE

### WEED REMOVAL



Weeds, dandelions and tall grass need to be below 8 inches tall. Therefore, it is necessary for residents and property owners to regularly cut the weeds on their property, which includes vacant lots, alleys and sidewalk areas surrounding their property.

### BRANCHES/YARD WASTE



Yard waste and Tree branches can be taken to the compost yard located at the Solid Waste Facility for NO CHARGE. The compost yard is open Monday – Saturday. During the summer residents can also bring grass clippings & branches (NO RUSSIAN OLIVE) to the Bar Nunn Tree Farm located behind the Fire Hall. Contact the Town Hall @ 237-7269.

### BUSHES/TREES



Bushes, trees and shrubs need to be trimmed away from the sidewalk, intersections, and alleys to allow for unobstructed vehicle and pedestrian traffic, and clear view.

### LITTER REMOVAL



Any person in control of private property is required to maintain the premise, alley and sidewalk areas free and clear of litter. All trash **MUST** be bagged and tied shut to prevent litter when garbage cans are emptied or blown over by the wind.

### RESIDENTIAL PAINT



**Residential** paint, oil, solvents, pesticides, caulk, and other chemicals can be discarded at the Special Waste and Diversion Facility located at the City of Casper Solid Waste Facility. Special Waste Facility is open Saturdays by appointment only. Call 235-8246, Monday through Friday to arrange an appointment. Quantities of used motor oil of 10 gallons or less can be taken to the Solid Waste Facility anytime. Contact the Sanitation Department @ 235-8246

### RV's/TRAILERS/BOATS

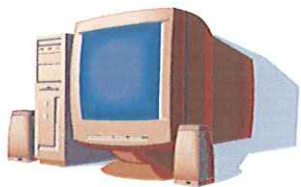


Motor homes, boats, campers, trailers, and other recreational vehicles cannot be stored on the street. These and other vehicles also may not be parked in the alley right-of-way.

### WHITE GOODS



Residents can dispose of white goods such as washers, dryers, dishwashers, and water heaters at the City of Casper Solid Waste Facility for NO CHARGE. Freon containing appliances, such as refrigerators, freezers and air conditioners may be taken to the Facility or to Wyoming Recycling for a fee. Contact the Sanitation Department at 235-8246 or Wyoming Recycling at 237-6615.



### ELECTRONICS

Residents can dispose of electronics such as computers, televisions, audio equipment, etc... at the City of Casper Solid Waste Facility for NO CHARGE.

### SIGNS



Garage sale and other signs cannot be placed in any city or state right-of-way. That includes signs on street signs, light poles, delineator posts, trees and street lights

### TIRES



Tires can be recycled at Wyoming Tire, Inc., located at 6925 Cactus Lane for a small fee. Call 235-0133 for more information. Residents may also dispose of standard-size passenger car or pickup truck tires, rimmed or de-rimmed, (limit 4) at the Solid Waste Facility for a special fee.

### FREE LANDFILL PASS

Each month the bottom portion of your sewer & garbage statement is a landfill pass. This pass is good for one free trip to the landfill for your disposal needs. **Landfill: (307) 235-8246, Hours: 7:30am – 4pm, Monday – Saturday.**



### RECYCLING

**Recycling bins are located on Sunset Blvd. by the fire station.** Bins are clearly marked for the items to be placed in them for recycling. There are bins marked for corrugated cardboard, newspapers, magazines, white/office paper (paper can be shredded), aluminum cans, glass containers, plastic bottles, and milk jugs. There is a separate bin for phone books, and one for string/ties/bags used in transporting recyclables.
